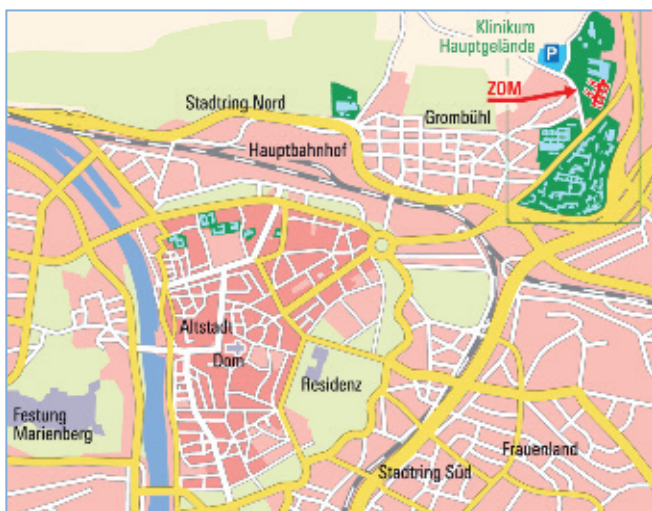

Location Map



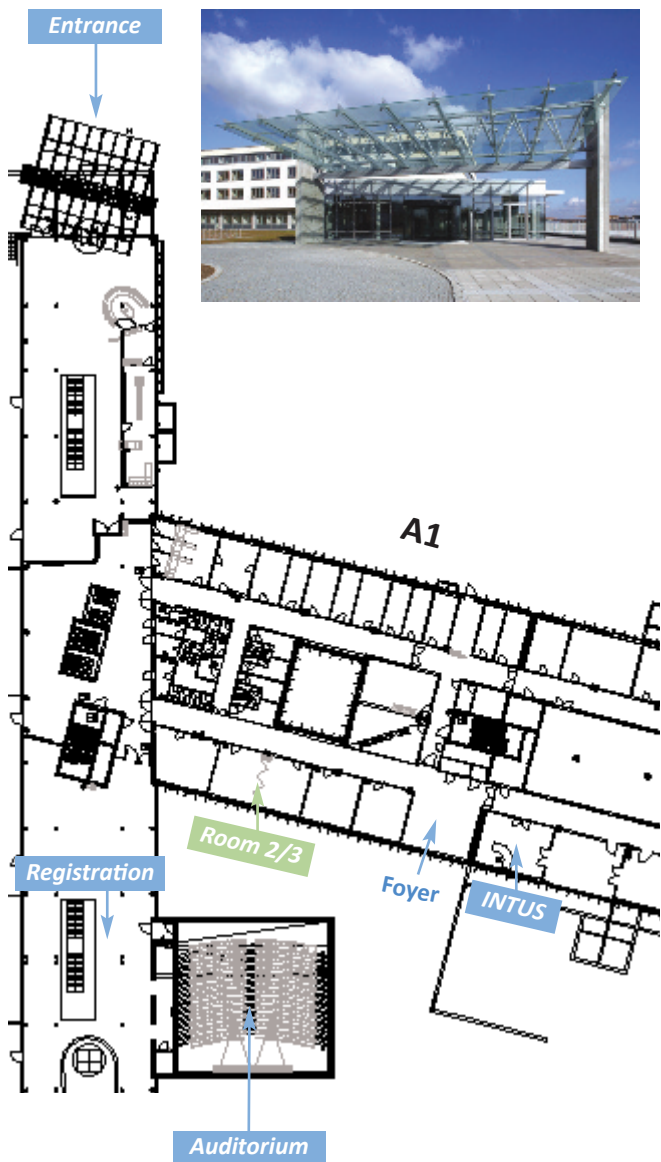
