# BOLOGNA 2005

Dear Colleague,

We are pleased to invite you to attend the ECCP/EACP second joint meeting. This will mark an important occasion, during which ECCP and EACP will officially merge to become the European Society of Coloproctology (ESCP). The ECCP/EACP meeting will be held in parallel with the first official meeting of the Italian Society of Colorectal Surgery (SICCR).

Following the success of the first joint EACP/ECCP meeting in Geneva last year, the 2005 meeting will commence on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> September with a pre-meeting live surgery course on modern management of rectal cancer. The official meeting will start on Thursday September 15<sup>th</sup> and will include a live surgery session on rectal prolapse surgery and symposia covering a wide range of topics, including difficulties in the management of colon cancer, long-term outcome of inflammatory bowel disease, radiation bowel disease, faecal incontinence and training in colon and rectal surgery. Several free paper sessions and keynote lectures are scheduled and the meeting will close with a consultants' corner featuring case presentations discussed by a panel of experts.

The Italian Society of Colorectal Surgery is an important association which brings together experts of this surgical specialty. The Society is greatly enthusiastic about this event and is thus offering an excellent opportunity to exchange information and results. The scientific programme will cover such topics as advanced colorectal cancer, comparison between laparoscopic and laparotomic surgery in diverticular disease, the study of the pelvic floor diseases, the most relevant aspects in the treatment of anal fistulae, the most recent problems of Crohn's disease. A poster session is scheduled: the session will be associated to a short discussion. Short lectures on specific arguments will be presented by the most important Italian experts.

There will be an attractive social programme with opportunities to visit many of the attractions offered by the beautiful city of Bologna, the seat of one of the first universities founded in the 12<sup>th</sup> century.

European Coloproctology is shortly to be united and we hope that you will respond to this important event by gracing the occasion with your attendance.

We look forward to seeing you in Bologna in September 2005.

This screen will not appear unless you have pressed the "Submit Abstract" button.

The presenting author (not co-authors) will receive confirmation in the event that the abstract has been received (approximately two weeks after submission). This notification is an acknowl-edgement of processing and does not indicate that the abstract has been selected for presentation at the conference.

The presenting author should contact EACP if no acknowledgement has been received within three weeks of submission. This can be done by e-mail or by contacting the EACP Secretariat by telephone or fax.

Authors of abstracts selected for oral presentation will be notified at the beginning of July 2005 for registration at the preferential early registration rate. If a selected author cannot attend the conference, the EACP should be notified with the name of the replacement presenter as soon as possible.

# By Air

Bologna is served by Bologna International Airport / Guglielmo Marconi Airport (BLQ), located near to Bologna city centre and also Forlì Airport (Società Esercizio Aeroporti). ATC Aerobus connects the city with the airports and leaves from in front of the train station roughly every 15 or 20 minutes until midnight. All the main European airlines have connections through the Guglielmo Marconi Airport and these include Aer Lingus, Air One, Air Alps Aviation, Air France, Alitalia, British Airways, EasyJet, KLM Dutch Airlines, Lufthansa, MALEV and Meridiana.

### By Bus at Bologna Airport

Regular buses are readily available and travel to and from the airport, stopping at the centre of Bologna. The Aerobus is an inexpensive way to travel and takes about 20 minutes.

## By Car at Bologna Airport

Cars can be readily hired at the airport. Passengers should take the Tangenziale road (bypass) to the city centre, and depending on traffic this journey can take as little as 10 minutes. Bologna has several main car parks, although these can prove expensive.

### By Taxi at Bologna Airport

A taxicab ride from the airport into the centre of Bologna is a relatively quick way to travel into the city centre, taking around 10 minutes. There are usually plenty of authorized taxis lined up by the main arrivals area of both terminals and the fares are quite reasonable. A taxi can also be called by phone at t. 051534141.

# By Road

When travelling by car, Bologna can be easily reached by the A1 Autostrada del Sole, which skirts around the city (the tangenziale) to the north and also connects Florence, Milan and Rome. At Bologna, the A1 from Milan leaves the Via Emilia and turns south towards Florence. The A14 continues on towards Ravenna and Rimini and the A13 runs north from Bologna to Ferrara and Padua. Many car rental agencies are available and there is a particularly good selection of these at Bologna Airport.

# By Train

Bologna Marconi Airport is located about 6 km from Bologna central railway station, which has good connections to major destinations across Italy and Europe. The Aerobus travels to the railway station approximately every 15 minutes.

Bologna is one of the main connections on the FS Italian rail network and has fast trains travelling to Florence, Milan, Ravenna, Rimini, Venice and most other regions in Italy from the Stazione Centrale in the Piazza Medaglie d'Oro. Bologna train station is situated on the north side of the city centre and is only a 10 minutes walk from the Piazza Maggiore and 5 minutes by bus or by taxi from the Congress Venue.

### WEATHER

Between May and September Bologna can become very hot and there can also be regular showers of heavy rain.

In September the daytime temperature range from 16°C to 24°C.
