



Report: The 3rd Three regional Congress

Verona - May 3, 2013

The 3rd Three regional Congress (Veneto, Friuli, Trentino) SICCR took place in Verona on the 3rd of May. Among the many issues discussed such as “Endometriosis and Rectum” the need of a Multidisciplinary collaboration (Gynaecologist, Colorectal Surgeon and Radiologist) was underlined. Moreover the importance of mini-invasive surgery was highlighted, particularly with the aim of even less cosmetic damage in the future (dr Ruffo – dr Ercoli).

The Congress was also the occasion to present the new “Veneto Group of Sacral Neurostimulation” (VENS), made up of the Centres of Conegliano, Treviso, Padova e Negrar, which have obtained and showed their results, particularly in faecal incontinence in Post-Radiotherapy and partial spinal damage.

The presentation of the Pathologist (dr Capelli) about the multiple different colitis inside the IBD session was of great interest: she underlined the need of a greater collaboration among the Clinician, Endoscopy specialist and Pathologist in order to achieve a more accurate diagnosis, due to more precise clinical -anamnestical reports.

Important last minute absences (dr Mistrangelo and dr Arezzo) resulted in a shortcoming of contributions regarding therapy in two important sessions (HPV and pre-neoplastic lesions – Cancerized adenoma). Nevertheless the debate was worthwhile.

The aim of the Congress was to incentivize useful open debates, not only through the most common treated pathologies in the Congresses (Rectal Cancer, IBD), but also through less frequently treated ones, such as Endometriosis and HPV related, which are an important part of the Colorectal Surgeon’s work. This aim was achieved thanks to the fruitful participation of all people involved.
