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International Symposium on APPROACH TO THE PATIENT WITH DISORDERS OF INTESTINAL FUNCTION

Classification of Disorders of Intestinal Function (DIF) into mutually exclusive categories based on predefined consensus criteria is useful to identify clinically homogeneous populations, but in many patients, do not match

- Natural clustering of symptoms
- Time course of symptom presentation
- Patient's report of symptoms
- Patient's judgement of his (her) own symptoms
- Physician's judgement of patient's symptoms
- Available, and newly emerging, drugs targeted to, and more relevant **contraindicated** in, specific subgroups of bowel disorders.

In addition predefined consensus criteria have progressively (from Manning to Rome I and II Criteria), excluded patients not matching the major clinical presentations of DIF (unspecified or *quasi* syndromes), and have emarginated patients with overlap syndromes. The main aim of the symposium is to provide critical and updated information useful for the management of patients with the different clinical presentations of DIF. These include (a) the major syndromes: IBS, IBS subtypes, Functional Diarrhea, Functional Constipation, Anorectopelvic dysfunction, Abdominal Pain, Abdominal Bloating, (b) the Unspecified *Quasi* syndromes, (c) the Overlap syndromes.
