

The great transformation in anorectal surgery has increased the importance of accurate pre operative studies in decision-making. Currently endorectal ultrasound remains the best way for accurately staging depth of penetration and presumptive nodal status in anorectal neoplasms, guiding therapeutic decisions by the identification of lesions suitable for local excision, laparoscopic resection or preoperative radiochemotherapy.

Moreover endoanal ultrasonography is recognized as an important diagnostic tool for the evaluation of benign anorectal disorders, including perianal abscesses and fistulas, incontinence and outlet obstruction.



The practical session has been organised in order to provide the delegates with hands-on experience in the basic use of ultrasonography and is designed to closely discuss specific details of the techniques.


Finally the Course includes a session of Live Surgery directly from the operating room to get a better understanding of the pathologic conditions evaluated by ultrasound.






