- **Surgical Complications Reduction Program in Colo-Rectal Cancer Screening & ERAS (Enhanced Recovery After Surgery):** the main research and studies activity was dedicated to the reduction of complications in patients operated on for colorectal cancer inside a colorectal cancer program related to an extended colorectal cancer screening program supported by the public health Italian government. Within this program a new procedure was developed for the surgery of low and ultra-low rectal cancer allowing the colo-anal reconstruction without any protective stoma, no complications and good functional results (SHIP procedure presented at ESCP- Nice 2018, France) (published on DCR , Technique in ColoProctology , Update Surgery).
- **The same program allowed to develop:**
 - a no-leaks anastomotic procedure in right hemicolectomy for right colon cancer;
 - the international randomized trial on Extralevator abdominoperineal excision (ELAPE)
- Author of more than 100 publications on international journals with impact factor reported on "pubmed.ncbi.nlm.gov" website in collaboration with many **international accredited institutions** and **scientific societies**.
- Authorship of 8 book chapters of international publishing house on colorectal topics
- Author of more than 100 congresses presentations
- Scientific coordinator of 10 congresses on colorectal and general surgery top
